whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "to secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto,

the claim of Jefferson Falconburg has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the Southwest quarter

of the South East quarter and the South East quarter of the South West quarter of section six in Township forty one North of Range fifteen West of the Fourth Principal Meridian in Wisconsin containing eighty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

Jefferson Falconburg
the tract of Land above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Jefferson Falconburg and to his heirs and assigns forever.
